

## Rhode Island Tobacco Prevention Spending, FY2000–FY2014



The CDC recommends that Rhode Island invest \$12.8 million a year on a comprehensive tobacco prevention program. In FY2014, Rhode Island invested 3% of the CDC's recommended amount.


## Rhode Island Tobacco Revenue, FY2000-FY2013
